California Proposition 65 (the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986) refers to California legislation that is intended to protect California residents and the state's drinking water sources from chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm. Proposition 65 requires businesses to warn Californians if a product will expose them to one of approximately 900 chemicals – including low levels of chemicals found in everyday products such as coffee, vinegar, fish, dyes, solvents and plastics...just to name a few.
